Frederick University accepts applications from candidates who have the required qualifications to fill the following part-time academic positions:

SCHOOL OF ARTS, COMMUNICATION AND CULTURAL STUDIES DEPARTMENT OF ARTS AND COMMUNICATION

Three (3) positions (one position for each academic field) at the rank of Special Teaching Staff in any of the following academic fields:

- Music, Audio Production & Engineering (for teaching the courses Audio
 Production & Technology I και Sound Design for Film & TV)
- Film & Video Production (for teaching the course Commercial: Storyboarding & Production)
- Film & Video Production (for teaching the courses Visual Representation in Films & Adv. Art Directing & Set Design)
- Cinematography for Digital Film & Television (for teaching the course Adv.
 Cinematography & Lighting)

For the position in the field of Music, Audio Production & Engineering applicants must hold:

- Bachelor or/and Master's degree from a recognized University relevant to the vacancy field
- At least five years of university teaching experience

- Professional experience, at least 5 years, in audio & music production and postproduction
- Relevant published scientific work is considered an additional qualification

For the positions in the field of Film & Video Production and Cinematography for Digital Film & Television applicants must hold:

- Master's degree from a recognized University relevant to the vacancy field
- At least three years of university teaching experience
- Professional experience, at least 5 years, in Film & Video Production as Film Director (Commercial and Fiction Films), and as Director of Cinematography (DOP) in various projects for TV and Cinema
- Relevant published scientific work is considered an additional qualification
