Frederick University invites applications for a Visiting Lecturer position in the following academic field:

• Water Resources Engineering: Hydraulics, Hydrology

The position is available both for full-time and part-time engagement for a fixed-term contract of at least 1-year duration.

For all the above vacancies applicants must hold:

- A Doctoral degree relevant to a field listed above
- Related internationally recognised research work.
- Prior experience in teaching at university level is considered a strong advantage.

The following would be considered as an advantage:

- Proven track record of scientific publications and attracting external research funding.
- Experience with interdisciplinary collaboration in areas such as Urban Water Systems, Integrated Water Resources Management, Climate Change Adaptation, Water-Energy-Food Nexus, or Data-Driven Methods in Water Engineering.
- Ability to contribute to curriculum development and teaching in both undergraduate and graduate-level courses related to fluid mechanics, hydraulic design, water resources engineering, hydrology (surface and groundwater), and other related topics.
