# WHAT IS ERASMUS+

---

*"A lifetime experience  
with a profound impact"*

The Erasmus+ program is the European Union's funded Program, which enables students and graduates to carry out mobility for studies or traineeship, receiving funding for living expenses, food and travel.



# PROGRAM OBJECTIVES

---

## Studying

- Teaching in international classrooms
- Learning new teaching methods
- CV Enrichment
- Getting to know new people and cultures

## Traineeship

- Helping students and graduates adapt to the EU labor market conditions
- Enabling students and graduates to develop specific skills, including language skills, and improve their understanding of the economic and social development of each country in the context of gaining professional experience.
- Contributing to the development of well-educated, open-minded, internationally experienced future professionals



# ELIGIBLE MOBILITIES

## Traineeship

- ❖ Placements take place in EU countries participating in the program, in companies, training centers, research centers, universities and other organizations other than EU institutions or embassies of the student's countries.
- ❖ Mobility for graduates is valid for up to 12 months exactly from the end of their mobility studies up to one year if no other period of mobility has preceded during the studies through the ERASMUS+ program.

# FINANCING YOUR MOBILITY

---

## Travel Expenses

### Distance amount

> 500 - 1999 km	_____	€275
> 2000 – 2999 km	_____	€360
> 3000 – 3999 km	_____	€530



Funding for travel expenses is **only** eligible for **students departing from Cyprus**

**1<sup>st</sup> instalment: 80%** before the beginning of mobility

**2<sup>nd</sup> installment: 20%** upon completion of the mobility and sending the required documents



For **internship** and **graduate** mobilities, the amounts increase by **150 euros**

## In particular:

- with physical, mental and mental disabilities
- with physical and mental health issues
- with a low socio-economic background
- with an immigrant/refugee background
- political refugee students/graduates
- who are children of single-parent or large-child families of low socio-economic background
- who are parents themselves and belong to the category of people with a low socio-economic background
- coming from rural, deprived, remote and critical areas
- who come from dysfunctional families (e.g. with drug addict parents, monitored by the Welfare Office, etc. )
- students/graduates with Learning Difficulties (e.g. Dyslexia, Dysgraphia, Dyspraxia etc. )
