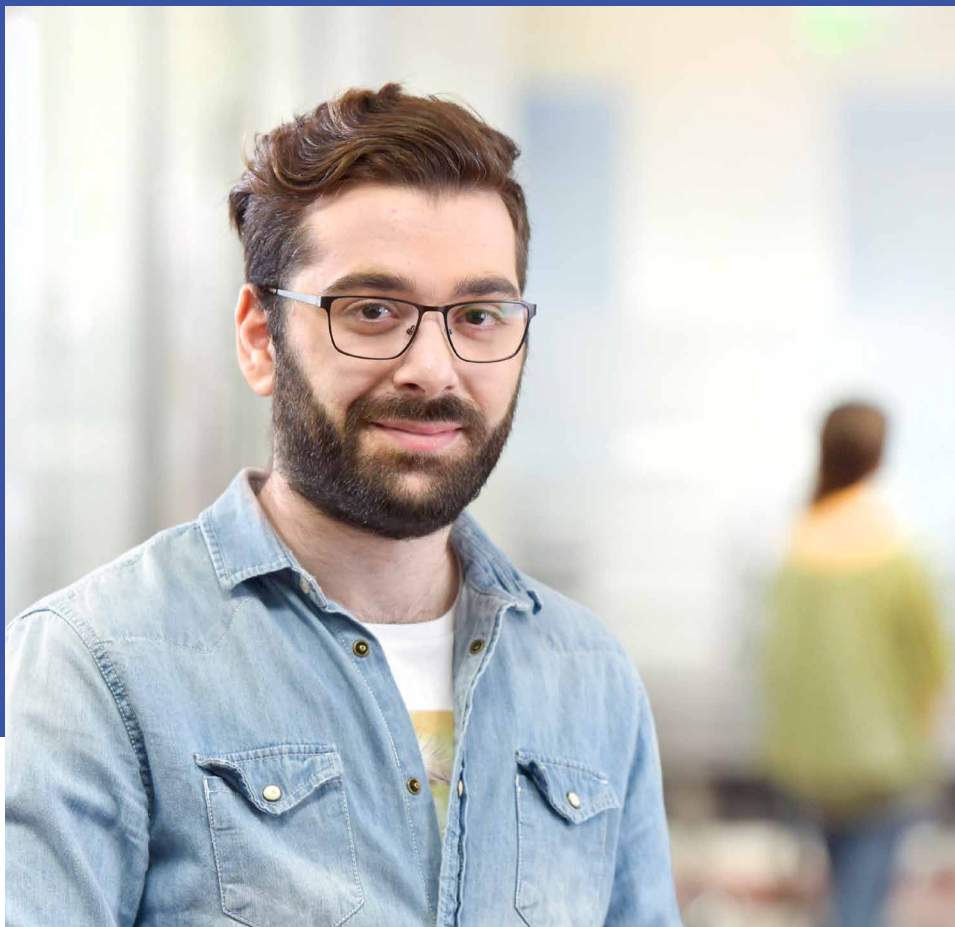

BA in Business Administration

The renewed Business Administration program at Frederick University is a versatile program designed for the next generation of business professionals. The General pathway covers the entire range of operations in a company and prepares you to enter the workforce and find employment in managerial positions in the public sector or companies and organizations of the private sector. Moreover, the program offers three distinctive specializations to choose from to give you a head start in the area that interests you the most. The program is available in both Nicosia and Limassol campuses, but also through distance learning.

Accounting specialization

Follow this pathway, if you want to specialize in Accounting, and obtain the professional titles of Chartered or Certified Accountant to take off your career. You will be exempt from the majority of exams by the Association of Chartered and Certified Accountants (ACCA) and the Association of International Accountants (AIA), and you will be eligible for full exemption from the exams for the professional qualification ACCA Foundations in Accountancy (FIA). You will be able to work at accounting and auditing firms, banks, financial advisory and investment firms, and in general in positions in the public or private sector requiring accounting and financial analysis.

Entrepreneurial Management Specialization

Through this pathway, you will acquire valuable skills and the knowledge to create and run a new business, whether you dream of starting your own company or joining a franchise network, taking over the family business, or joining a small and promising company. You will learn to evaluate business opportunities, develop business plans, analyze financial and other data, identify and solve operational problems effectively.

Digital Marketing Specialization

Choose this pathway, and you will walk away with the Certified Digital Marketing Associate (CDMA) certificate. CDMA is a globally recognized accreditation awarded by the Digital Marketing Institute (DMI), the leading digital marketing professional training and certification body, which has a strategic partnership with Frederick University. As a graduate, you will have what it takes to pursue career opportunities in marketing and digital marketing. You will learn to design and implement marketing and digital marketing strategies, use social media to achieve business goals, apply SEO and e-commerce strategies, analyze data, and use state-of-the-art technologies and digital marketing platforms.
